Subject: Cancellation / Rejection of Re-registration application of Bashir

Ahmad Wani R/o Malwari, District-Pulwama (under 32C of the

Pharmacy Act, 1948-regarding).

Whereas, the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a Public Notice under endorsement no:JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, Dated: 16.12.2020 & JKPC-284-Estt-793-807, Dated: 28.08.2023 inviting therein applications for reregistration/validation of Pharmacist Registration certificates of all those persons who were registered as Pharmacist under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011, (1955, A.D);

Whereas, the above exercise was initiated in pursuance to provisio (32C) incorporated in the Pharmacy Act, 1948;

Whereas, an application from **Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Malwari**, **District-Pulwama** was uploaded in the Online Portal vide Form reference no: PHAR022876;

Whereas, after perusal of office records/scrutiny of uploaded documents following discrepancies were observed;

- That the registration certificate uploaded has not been prepared/signed by any of the Office bearers of the Council;
- ii. That the signature of issuing authority also does not belong to any one of the competent authorities who have discharged such role in the Council;

Whereas, the observations highlighted herein above suggests that the registration as Pharmacist as uploaded by Sh. Bashir Ahmad Wani is not issued by the competent authority;

Whereas, Sh. Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Malwari, District-Pulwama was offered an opportunity to provide his response in the matter to a show cause

notice served upon the said person vide this office letter bearing no: JKPC/SCN/2023/PHAR022876-1072-1088, Dated: 26.09.23;

Whereas, no reply was received from the applicants end;

Whereas, the applicant has failed to respond to the communication reflected in para supras and therefore the applicant has not availed of his right to be heard before a decision in the matter is taken.

Now, therefore the undersigned in exercise of powers vested under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 rejects the claims of the applicant for re-registration as Pharmacist in terms of Section 32C of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, on the ground that no such certificate has been issued/granted by the J&K Pharmacy council under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011.
