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It is impressed upon all the institutions conducting various courses in Pharmacy in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir to secure due diligence with the below regulation(s) notified by the Apex regulatory body of the country i.e Pharmacy Council of India from time to time through various Gazette notifications:

- a) The Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy.
- b) The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
- c) The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
- d) Pharm.D Regulations, 2008.
- e) Bachelor of Pharmacy (Practice) Regulations, 2014.
- f) Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
- g) Pharmacy Practice Regulations, 2015.
