CIRCULAR:

The Jammu & Kashmir Pharmacy Council is entrusted with the mandate to regulate the practice and profession of Pharmacy in the Union Territory of J&K. One of the important role assigned to the Council is to maintain a register of Pharmacists on the basis of eligibility prescribed under the regulation, i.e the Pharmacy Act, 1948 read with Education Regulations notified by the Apex body from time to time.

The Pharmacy Council of India maintains a Central Register of Pharmacists which is published at their end after each calendar year. In order to help the State Pharmacy Council to update the list of registered Pharmacists maintained by it, it becomes imperative for the stakeholders to report / inform the death of a registered Pharmacist which comes to their notice.

The Licensing Authorities appointed by the Government under Rule (59) of the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 are requested to notify to the J&K Pharmacy Council information regarding death of a Registered Pharmacist while discharging statutory functions under the said regulation. The successors of deceased registered Pharmacists are also requested through the medium of this circular to extend their cooperation to the Council & inform about any such event.
