SUBJECT:- Cancellation /Rejection of Re-registration application of Mr. Parshotam Kumar S/o Rattan Chand, R/o Palail, Tehsil Billawar, Distt- Kathua, J&K.(under 32C of the Pharmacy Act 1948-regarding).

Whereas, the Pharmacy Council of Union Territory of J&K issued a Public Notice under endorsement no:JKPC-86/Estt/681-91, Dated: 16.12.2020 inviting therein applications for re-registration/validation of Pharmacist Registration certificates of all those persons who were registered as Pharmacist under the repealed J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011, (1955, A.D);

Whereas, the above exercise was initiated in pursuance to provision (32C) incorporated in the Pharmacy Act, 1948 notified vide S.O no: **3465(E)**, **Dated: 05**th **of October, 2020**;

Whereas, an applicant namely Shri Parshotam Kumar S/o Rattan Chand, R/o Palail, Tehsil Billawar, Distt- Kathua, J&K uploaded an application in the Online Portal of J&K Pharmacy Council for re-registration under (32C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 vide Form reference no: PHAR024351;

Whereas, after perusal of office records/scrutiny of uploaded documents following discrepancies were observed;

- That the registration number: 6992 mentioned in the uploaded certificate actually belongs to Mr. Hakim Sajad Ahmad Shah S/o Hakim Hafiz Ullah hah R/o Court Road Dangarpura Srinagar,
- That the registration certificate has not been prepared/ signed by any of the Office bearers of the Council;

Whereas, the observations highlighted herein above suggests that the above person has adopted unfair means by uploading fake documents/credentials;

Whereas, the above person was offered an opportunity to provide his response in the matter through show cause/personnel appearance notice vide this office letter bearing no: JKPC/SCN/2024/Estt-591-603, Dated: 16.10.2024;

Whereas, reply received from the applicant's side has been examined & found devoid of any merit;

Now, therefore the undersigned in exercise of powers vested under Section (41) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 rejects the application of the applicant for re-registration as Pharmacist in terms of Section 32(C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
