
## PUBLIC NOTICE/ADVISORY

The J&K Pharmacy Council adopted an Online Portal for Registration of eligible candidate as Pharmacist on the basis of eligibility acquired by applicants under the provisions of the Pharmacy Act, 1948. The portal was launched by our Worthy Financial Commissioner, Health & Medical Education, J&K, Sh. Atal Dulloo, (IAS) on 16.12.2020. The sole objective of offering Online services to the intending applicants was to reduce physical interface as also to offer services to the applicants at their doorsteps.

After holding a review of the performance of the online portal, it has been observed that some applicants are not uploading correct information under 32C option which is resulting in delayed disposal of such applications. In order to address this issue the stake holders are advised to follow the below pictorial manual carefully before uploading the personal information:











The Council as an abundant precaution has also provided an instruction manual on its Website, i.e www.jkpc.in to avoid any lapse. Further, it has also been observed that applicants who do not hold the relevant qualification mandated under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 are applying for fresh registration. Such applicants are advised to refer to Education Regulations hold the relevant qualification mandated under the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time to establish their eligibility.
